What is the Joy of the Lord?

The joy of the Lord is when we have a supernatural confidence that our God is sovereign. Our God is loving, powerful and for us! When we understand, through the Holy Spirit, that no matter what our circumstances are, where we are in life, God is working ALL things out for our good!

Before Jesus was born, Mary sang a song of joy:

47 and my spirit rejoices in God my Savior, Luke 1:47

The night Jesus was born, the angels brought good news of joy:

10 But the angel said to them, "Don't be afraid, for look, I proclaim to you good news of great joy that will be for all the people: Luke 2:10

Jesus lived with joy! He spoke that he was like the bridegroom at His own wedding feast and people even accused Him of being too joyful. Jesus told us, His followers, that He teaches us for His own joy and there is a portion of that joy for us!

Joy is the cornerstone of our relationship with God. Our memory verse for the next 30 days says our strength comes from the joy of the Lord! Our relationship with God is set on a foundation of joy.

As you work through these verses I pray that the Lord fills your heart with joy and peace, the confidence of knowing God loves you and is working for your good!
