

Great Gain

Paul says that in fact being godly does result in great gain, but that gain is not material. Consider the following questions about the wonderful great gains the Lord brings to your life.

1. Cultivating a Deeper Understanding of God's Blessings:

- What specific ways has God blessed me? *Consider the tangible and intangible benefits in your life, such as family, health, relationships, work, financial stability, and inner peace.*
- How have these blessings impacted my life? *Reflect on the ways these blessings have contributed to your well-being and growth.*

- How can I better appreciate and recognize God's hand in these blessings? *Seek opportunities to express gratitude and thank God for His favor.*

2. Examples of God's Favor:

- What specific instances in my life can I point to as evidence of God's grace and favor?. *Look for moments where God intervened, guided, or provided unexpected blessings.*
- How has God answered my prayers and met my needs?. *Reflect on answered prayers, both small and large, that have brought joy and peace to your life.*
- How have my circumstances changed for the better, and how can I attribute these changes to God's favor?. *Recognize the ways God has led you through challenging times and guided you toward growth and prosperity.*

3. Cultivating Contentment:

- How can I cultivate a heart of contentment in all circumstances, even when facing challenges? *Embrace the idea that true gain comes from godliness and contentment, not just material wealth.*
- How can I focus on the things I have, rather than the things I lack or desire? *Practice gratitude and appreciate the blessings in your life, big and small.*
- How can I find joy and peace in my current circumstances, regardless of external factors? *Cultivate a strong relationship with God and trust in His plan for your life.*

4. Sharing Gratitude:

- How can I actively share my gratitude with others and encourage them to seek God's blessings in their lives? *Share stories of God's favor, offer words of encouragement, and lead by example.*

- How can I use my blessings to serve others and make a positive impact in the world?. *Use your talents, resources, and opportunities to bless others and spread God's love.*

- How can I be a positive influence on others and help them to see the great gains of God in their own lives?. *Be a source of hope and encouragement, and demonstrate the power of faith and grace in your own life.*
